Strategic Energy Infrastructure

Risberg Transmission Pipeline Project

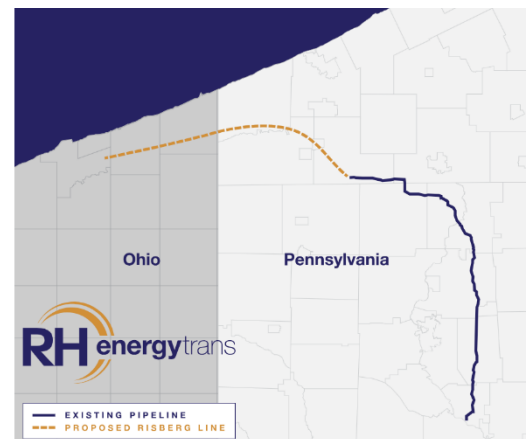
The **Risberg Pipeline** delivered a major natural gas infrastructure investment connecting Meadville, PA to North Kingsville, OH.

Project Impact

- ~\$100M investment
- Expanded high-capacity natural gas availability for industrial users, allowing Ashtabula County to attract new businesses and jobs
- Strengthened regional utility reliability and competitiveness
- Enabled growth opportunities for energy-intensive manufacturers, power generation, and data centers
- Positioned Ashtabula County for future large-scale industrial development

The Risberg Line Route

The Risberg Pipeline route will begin in the Meadville, PA area and extend in a northwest direction to Ashtabula County. The project will use approximately 32 miles of existing pipeline in an established Right of Way originating in the Meadville, PA area. Approximately 16 miles of new pipeline will be installed in Pennsylvania and approximately 12 miles of new pipeline will be installed in Ohio.



Manufacturing Expansion

Green Bay Packaging / Third Dimension – Geneva

Green Bay Packaging acquired **Third Dimension Inc.** and expanded operations in Geneva.

Project Impact

- **112,000 sq. ft. facility expansion; ~\$22M capital investment**
- **Created 47 full-time permanent jobs and retained 63 full-time permanent jobs**
- Increased production capacity for corrugated packaging, digital printing, and protective solutions
- Strengthens regional supply chain capabilities
- Supports job growth and long-term manufacturing investment in the county



Advanced Manufacturing Investment

Kennametal Expansion – Orwell

Kennametal completed a major modernization and expansion at its Orwell facility.

Project Impact

- **Facility upgrades and advanced manufacturing technology investments totaling nearly \$150M**
- **Supported the retention of 275 high-skill, high-wage production jobs**
- Enhances global competitiveness of a long-standing local employer
- Reinforces Ashtabula County's strength in precision manufacturing
